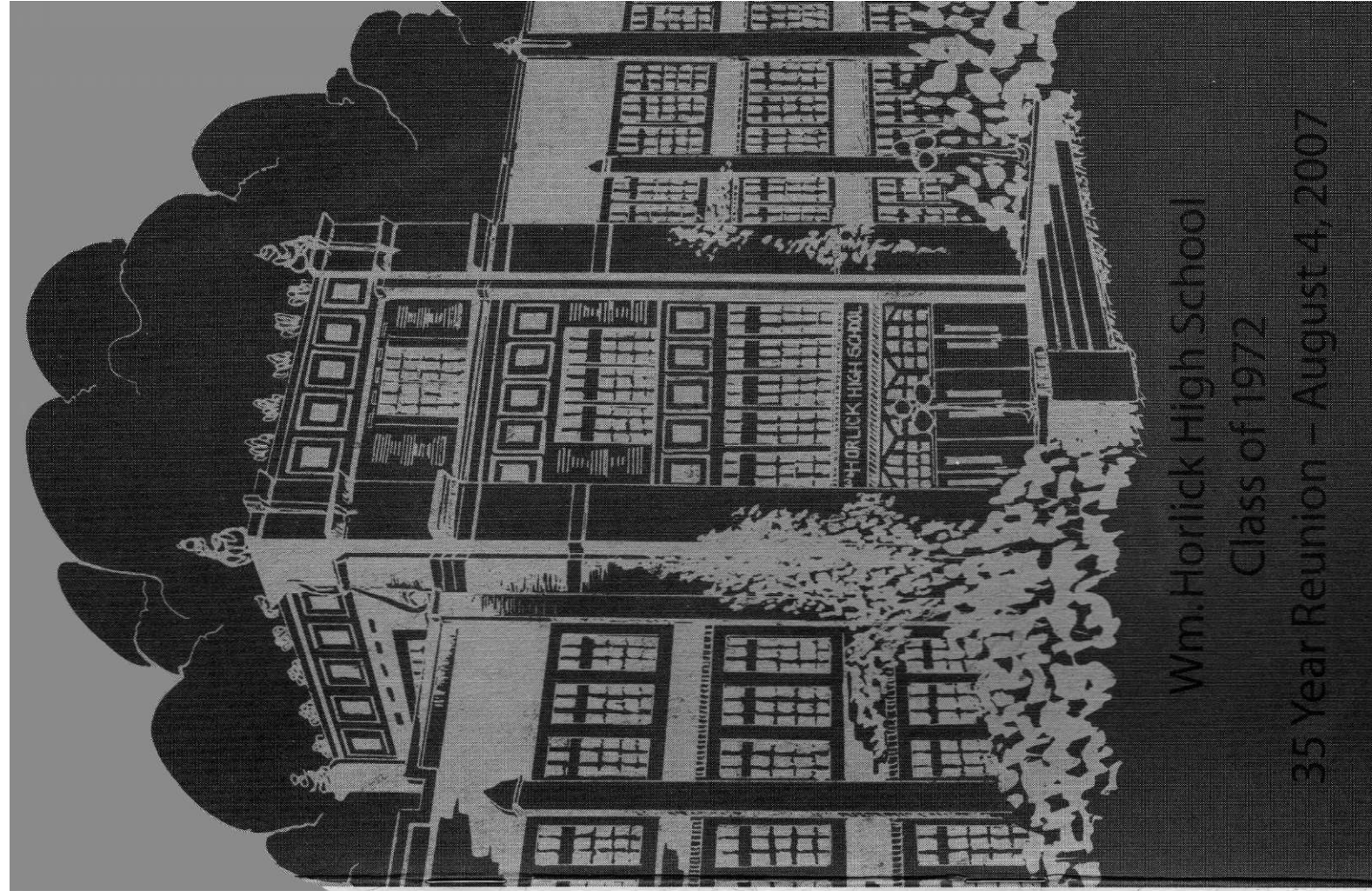

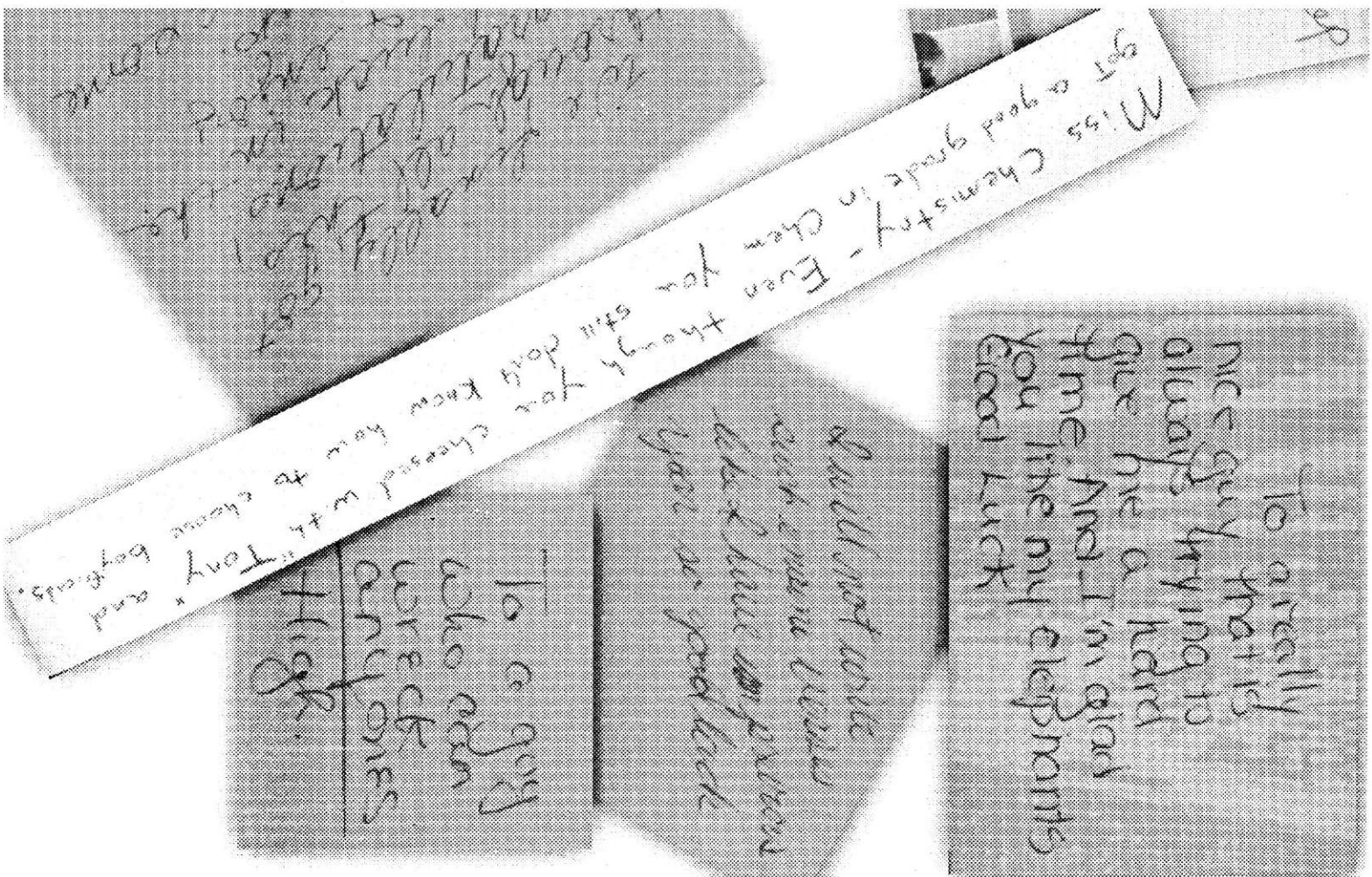

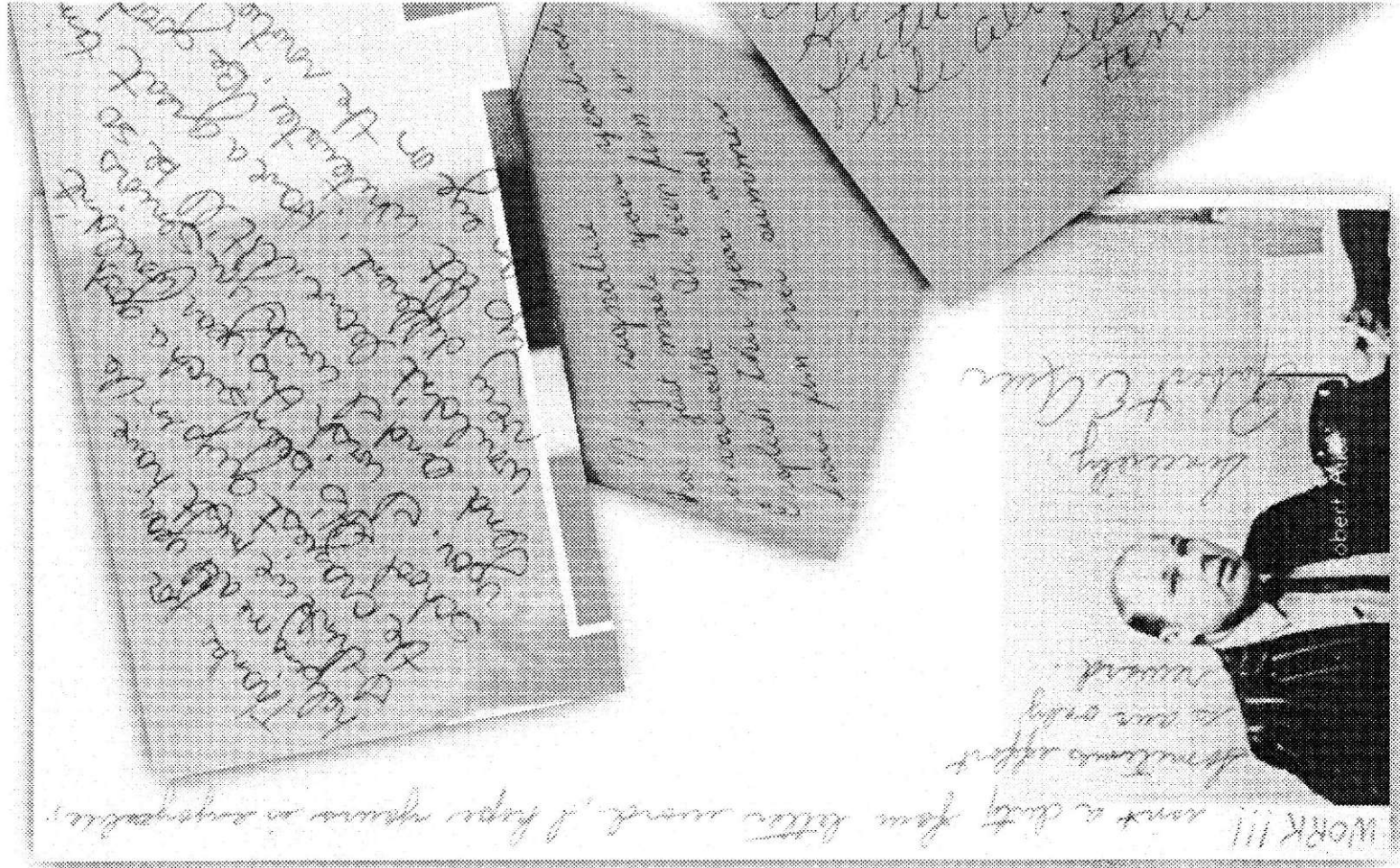
## We're booming now...

When we were lounging around the Commons during open mods "solving" the world problems with the idealism of youth – blissfully unaware of the gift of a faster metabolism that allowed us to eat whatever, exercise whenever, and still zip up our bellbottom jeans with no difficulty – little did we know that we were destined for big things.

Besides being part of the graduating class of 1972, we also happen to be part of a much larger, more powerful group – baby boomers. The "boomer generation," people born between 1946 and 1964, was the result of an unusual spike in birth rates following World War II. We were the first group to be raised on television and television has been identified as the institution that solidified the sense of generational identity more than any other. Thirty-five years later, only the Brat Stop has endured, the Chancery has moved downtown, and Paradise went from North to West; the rest are memories – or at least not in the phone book.

In 2007, while bellbottoms have made a comeback, our metabolisms are faltering, but we have actually become a force in solving world problems. The sense of community and family will always be there to carry us through. If we have to be a sandwich, it might as well be a hero sandwich.
